

## **Lincoln County SD**

**Funded amount \$425,000**

Lincoln County School District is a 1,000 square mile countywide district. Our District is one of the nation's highest poverty school districts. We will serve approximately 187 K-12 students at six afterschool sites. Our afterschool programs focus on: Science, Technology, Engineering, [Art], Mathematics (STEAM/STEM); literacy; and Career and Technology Education (CTE).

### **These sites, their grades served, and their program format include:**

- Waldport Middle (WMS), 7-8, club-based
- Newport High (NHS), 9-12, club-based
- Crestview Heights (CVH), K-6 and 2 high school assistants, instructor-led
- Siletz Valley Schools (SVS), K-5, instructor-led
- Lincoln City Rec Center (RecKids), partner site, K-6, instructor-led
- Neighbors For Kids (NFK), partner site, K-12, student choice stations

Several clubs at WMS and NHS rotate throughout the year allowing student choice. Other clubs remain the same throughout the year allowing students to immerse themselves in the projects.
