Goal #1	COIC JDEP will test all JDEP students for Math and English on LetsGoLearn and use information from assessments to assign appropriate online classes in Odysseyware, Aztec and LetsGoLearn Edge.
Short-Term Outcome	95% of students (who are our identified focal students) will complete at least one LetsGoLearn during school year. Students will then be placed in Math Edge and/or English Language Arts Edge in order to gain skills in needed areas according to test findings and fill in gaps in skills in math and reading/language arts skills. Teacher (I staff) during intake will test each student prior to their placement.
Long-Term Outcome	Prevent dropouts and increase graduation rates. Students will be able to use skills gained to obtain high school credits, pass GED tests and obtain jobs. 95% of all students will be tested by the end of the 2024-25 school year.
Goal #2	Continue to enroll students (who are our identified focal students) in appropriate Odysseyware course work to earn credits towards diploma or gaining skills to pass GED test. Increase the use of Aztec Learning for students studying for the GED. Offer all students the choice of taking the Life Skills Series and Ready for Work offered through Aztec after they have completed LetsGoLearn basic skills testing.
Short-Term Outcome	Teacher will work individually with each student to identify courses in Aztec/Odysseyware/LetsGoLearn/LifeSkills that will meet their individual academic needs and personal interests. This works creates buy-in and keeps them on track towards graduation. By the end of the 2022-23 school year The teacher will have met with all students that remain in the program. The only students not met with our those that leave before there is the opportunity. Students will be enrolled in at least one Odysseyware career course related to student interests to keep students engaged in school and reduce absenteeism. GED students will be able to study for the GED in Odysseyware and Aztec in order to give students more options to increase engagement and to have different approaches to studying. The Life Skills Series and Ready for work will increase skills to be able to keep emotionally regulated and able to find employment.
Long-Term Outcome	Prevent dropouts and increase graduation rates of students as they move on to other schools and programs. Students will be able to use skills gained to obtain high school credits, pass GED tests and obtain jobs. Increase in the baseline data of COIC Ecosystem by 2% by the end of the 2024-25 school year.
