Lead Organization	Coquille School District
Goal #1	100% of ninth grade students will be on track to graduate in the Coquille School District.
Short-Term Outcome	By the end of the 2022-2023 school year each high school will have an academic counselor on staff. All Freshman will have met with an academic counselor and established a four year class schedule. The academic counselors will meet with the Indian Education Coordinator, Homeless Liaison, and Special Education Case Manager's at each school to make sure all three focal groups are represented and are on track to graduate.
Long-Term Outcome	By the 2024-25 school year the district wide ninth grade on track percentage will reach 75% on track to graduate.
Goal #2	The Coquille School District will have all students college and career ready upon graduation from high school.
Short-Term Outcome	Both high schools will provide multiple opportunities for students to visit colleges virtually and in-person. The academic counselors will meet with the Indian Education Coordinator, Homeless Liaison, and Special Education Case Manager's at each school to make sure all three focal groups are represented in college and career education opportunities. All seniors will fill out college applications, apply for FASFA, and attend regional career fairs.
Long-Term Outcome	By the end of 2024-25 school year the Coquille School District will have 75% participation from all seniors in complete their college and career ready activities.
Goal #3	The Coquille School District will strive to improve district attendance through our Chronic Absenteeism efforts.
Short-Term Outcome	The Chronis Absenteeism Coordinator will meet with the Indian Education Coordinator, Homeless Liaison, and Special Education Case Manager's at each school to make sure all three focal groups are represented in Chronic Absenteeism efforts.
Long-Term Outcome	By the end of 2024-25 school year the Coquille School District Chronic Absenteeism rate will drop from 25% to 15 %.
Goal #4	The Coquille School District will ensure equitable access for all students to participate in college level opportunities.
Short-Term Outcome	The academic counselors will meet with the Indian Education Coordinator, Homeless Liaison, and Special Education Case Manager's at each school to make sure all three focal groups are represented in college level opportunities. This will include CTE programs, advanced placement courses, duel credit college classes, and online or in-person college classes.
Long-Term Outcome	By the end of the 2024-2025 school year 75% of all graduating seniors will have participated in one or more of the college level opportunities offered by the Coquille School District.

Dropout Prevention Activity #1	The Coquille School District will hire two academic counselors one for each high school to meet with all 9th grade students to map out a plan to reach graduation and beyond, with more targeted outreach to focal student populations.
