Lead Organization	Creswell SD
Goal #1	86% of students will be on-track toward graduation after completing 9th grade.
Short-Term Outcome	Grade level teams (teachers and relevant support staff) are meeting regularly, looking at data, student supports are tracked for effectiveness and students and families are involved in the evaluation of those supports. Students will be presented with plans to meet the 9th grade on track requirements.
Long-Term Outcome	The overall 9th grade on-track rate of students will increase by 5%.
Goal #2	Ensure Program of Study alignment to current industry standards, with all existing and new Programs in each career learning area and develop more partnership approaches through K-12, Lane CC, and industry to encourage partnerships, joint professional development, and more real-life opportunities (i.e. in class projects, internships, externships) for students/educators/career guidance and academic counselors.
Short-Term Outcome	Teachers and programs will complete the requirements to be considered Programs of Study. Program of Study teachers, along with the guidance counselor, will develop new partnerships with local industry partners.
Long-Term Outcome	Our 4 Program of Study areas will meet all the necessary requirements to be considered a pathway. All Freshman will be given the opportunity to explore our four pathways. Our "completers' numbers will grow from 0 per pathway to 5 students per pathway. Teachers and staff will develop one community industry partnership per pathway for students to participate in.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	We will hold weekly student success team meetings to identify struggling students and establish plans of support with a focus on students who are historically underserved, students with disabilities, and students experiencing poverty. Parents and students will be encouraged to participate in the development and follow through of those plans.
