Lead Organization	Glendale School District
Goal #1	95% of 9th grade students will leave 9th grade on track to graduate
Short-Term Outcome	90T rate will raise by 10% by the end of the 22-23 School year. HS Graduation coach will work monthly with classroom teachers at monthly teacher meetings with intervention notes.
Long-Term Outcome	90T rate will raise by 15% by the 24-25 school year. The Graduation coach and 9th grade team will support this work.
Goal #2	All students will have a clear path identified toward graduation, as well as their post-secondary plans for college, career, CTE and advanced coursework exposure starting in 7th grade by the end of 22-23 school year.
Short-Term Outcome	The Graduation Coach and classroom teachers will look at data and PEP monthly to support this goal. There will be a 10% increase in students taking advanced coursework
Long-Term Outcome	There will be a 10% increase in students taking advanced coursework.
Goal #3	Reduce Chronic Absenteeism across all student populations by 10% by the end of the 22-23 school year.
Short-Term Outcome	Reduce CA by 10% by 22-23. The attendance team gets data weekly from the Graduation Coach and follows up with interventions with notes.
Long-Term Outcome	Reduce CA by 15% by the 24-25 school year. The attendance team will continue to meet with the Graduation Coach and review data, interventions, and notes.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	The Graduation Coach and 9th grade team will meet monthly to review BAG data and advanced course data. There is a staff allocation for the Graduation Coach which was paid out of M98 before. There are also planning and data review stipends for staff.

Dropout Prevention Activity #2	The CA team meets weekly to review data and interventions. The CA team meets in the summer and fall beyond the work day for CA Professional Learning.
