Goal #1	9th grade on track percentage will improve by 10 percentage points from the 18-19 cohort for the following groups of students: Male - Improve to 60% Underserved Races/Ethnicities - Improve to 43% Students with Disabilities - Improve to 60%
Short-Term Outcome	Freshmen teachers, administration, and the counselor will meet regularly to examine 9th-grade student data and develop interventions for struggling students.
Long-Term Outcome	9th grade on track percentage will improve by 10 percentage points from the 18-19 cohort for the following groups of students: Male - Improve to 60% Underserved Races/Ethnicities - Improve to 43% Students with Disabilities - Improve to 60%
Goal #2	develop or obtain a tracking method for efficient, succinct identification and tracking of students at risk.
Short-Term Outcome	identify and try different trackers from other schools, or perhaps a commercially available product using EIS grant funds if we are awarded the grant.
Long-Term Outcome	A tracking method is in place and regularly used by administration and teachers to identify and track the progress of any 7-12 grade at-risk student.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	An attendance intervention specialist was hired several years ago to track attendance and intervene when necessary. This position has historically been funded with these funds.
