**Severe Need:** Rate for schools determined to be severe need because they serve a high percentage of children in need and meet the following eligibility criteria:

- 40% or more of lunches served in 2022-2023 were served to Free or Reduced Price-eligible students by site.

**Oregon Payment:** The Oregon Payment reimbursements are paid in addition to the federal reimbursements. They are funded by the State of Oregon budget, and are subject to change each biennium.

- OR EIG: For public school sponsors using the Oregon Expanded Income Guidelines .
- OR CEPI: For public school sponsors approved to use the Community Eligibility Provision Incentive Program.
- Reduced-Price: for public school sponsors that serve no charge breakfast to students eligible for federal reduced price breakfast.

\*\* Seamless Summer Option: An additional payment of .05 for breakfast and lunch meals served in May - September.

**Fewer than 60% Free-eligible:** The reimbursement rate for School Food Authorities which *served* fewer than 60 percent free and reduced price lunches in 2022-2023 school year, district wide.

**60% or More Free-eligible:** The reimbursement rate for School Food Authorities which *served* 60 percent or more free and reduced price lunches in 2022-2023 school year, district wide.

*This percentage is calculated at the State Agency when the Claim for Reimbursement is paid.*

**Oregon Payment:** The Oregon Payment reimbursements are paid in addition to the federal reimbursements. They are funded by the State of Oregon budget, and are subject to change each biennium.

Fewer than 50% Free-Eligible: The reimbursement rate for snacks served in afterschool care programs in schools where fewer than 50% of enrolled students, as of most the recent October, are Free or Reduced Price-eligible.

50% or More Free-Eligible: The reimbursement rate for snacks served in afterschool care programs in schools where 50% or more of enrolled students, as of the most recent October, are Free or Reduced Price-eligible.

### Special Milk Program

No Applications: No applications are distributed to Parents/Guardians. The school has a policy to *sell* milk to all students or *offer milk at no cost* to all students. Schools that choose this option receive the *All Milk* reimbursement for each half-pint of milk served to students.

Free Milk With Applications: Eligibility for Free milk is determined by confidential applications or direct certification from Adult and Family Services. Schools offering this option receive the *Free Milk* reimbursement (the average price the school pays for each half-pint of milk) served to Free-eligible students and the *Paid Milk* reimbursement for students who must pay for their milk.

### Commodity Entitlement Rate

The commodity entitlement rate for school year 2023-2024 is \$0.365 for lunch meals served.
