Update on Latino/a/x Student Success Grants – 9:15 Michael Reyes	ODE staff shared updated about the Interim Latinx Student Success Grants. The agency recived 34 applications which are currently being reviewed. A total of \$1 million in funding will be awarded the following week. Because of the quick timeline for this grant application, the grant reviewers are all ODE staff who have a strong equity and anti-racist lens.  Committee members asked the agency to consider inviting outside reviewers for future grant reviews. Future grant opportunities are dependent on funding from the legislature.
