


IMPLEMENTATION PLAN PURPOSE

- Identify and assess rail policies, actions and projects that could be implemented or supported by ODOT
- Streamline and standardize the tracking and funding prioritization of rail projects
- Support transparency and thorough documentation of decision-making
- Leverage Federal and State funds

- Consistent with OSRP and FRA State Rail Plan Guidance


