Topic	Questions	Answers
<b>General Questions about Attesting</b>	Where can I view these slides or the presentation?	Webinar materials are included on our <a href="#">website</a> , including the recorded <a href="#">Program Year 2021 Webinar</a> .
	Are eligible professionals able to participate if they participated in Meaningful Use previously?	Yes; if they attested and received a Medicaid EHR Incentive Program payment for a previous program year, and have not exceeded the participation maximum (six year limit).
	Is this the last year of Meaningful Use?	For the Medicaid EHR Incentive Program, yes. Eligible professionals may also be eligible for the <a href="#">Merit-based Incentive Payment System (MIPS)</a> , which will continue beyond 2021.
<b>Stage 3 Meaningful Use Objectives and Measures</b>	For <a href="#">Objective 8, Measure 1</a> (Public Health and Clinical Data Registry Reporting - Immunization Registry Reporting) how do we know if we have the bidirectional connection set-up? She can verify whether ALERT IIS has a record of bidirectionality for your organization. You can also reach out to your EHR vendor for additional information.
	Is the electronic Clinical Quality Measures (eCQM) report for a 90-day period or the entire year?	The eCQM reporting period for 2021 is any continuous 90-day period January 1, 2021 – August 31, 2021 (August 31 is the last day to submit a Program Year 2021 attestation, so the eCQM reporting period cannot go beyond that date).
