

Percent change since 2001, adjusted for inflation



- Median renter household income




Low-Income Renters in Many States Struggled to Pay Rent Before Pandemic Worsened Hardship



Share of adult renters reporting that their household was not caught up on rent, by race




SHARE OF ADULT OREGON RENTERS NOT CAUGHT UP ON RENT



EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS ON A GIVEN NIGHT IN JANUARY 2020


