
IMPROVED MATERNAL HEALTH

- 96% of mothers screened for substance use risk
- 87% of mothers screened for intimate partner violence
- 96% of mothers screened for depressive symptoms

POSITIVE PARENTING




- 69% increase in use of the safety checklist
- 100% decrease in above normal parenting stress



CHILD DEVELOPMENT

- 25% increase in screening for social-emotional development
- 58% decrease in child abuse and neglect
- 100% enrollment in a health plan



CONNECTING SYSTEMS

Families receiving home visiting services are more likely to be connected to other important services and supports.



Home visiting services are voluntary and provided at no cost to the family. They are a solid community investment yielding

\$4 - \$9 for every dollar invested.

Home visiting is an effective family support strategy to improve maternal and child health, parenting skills, family safety and economic self-sufficiency and school readiness.
