Starting July 1, 2022, **people who are 19-25 or 55 and older** are eligible for full Oregon Health Plan benefits no matter what their immigration status is. Children under 19 have been eligible since 2017.

- The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) submitted a program implementation report to the Oregon Legislature January 13, 2023.
