

Oregon Plan for Salmon and Watersheds House and Senate Bills

House Bill 3700

Forest products tax to help fund Watershed Improvement Grant Fund. Signed and dated March 25, 1997.

House Bill 5042

Appropriation of funds to state agencies from the general fund, in order to implement the Oregon Plan. Signed and dated March 25, 1997.

Senate Bill 924

Recognition and implementation of Oregon Plan. Signed and dated March 25, 1997.

House Bill 5044

Adjustment of appropriations of funds that was originally determined in HB 5042, adjusting maximum agency budgets if new salmonid ESU's were listed by NMFS. Signed and dated April 11, 1997.

Letter of Clarification

Sent from the president of the senate and speaker of the house to the Governor, discussing the appropriation of monies in HB 5042 and 5044, in relation to the listing of salmonid species in Oregon ESU's. Dated and signed May 8, 1997.

House Bill 5044 (A-Engrossed)

House Bill 3225

Creating new provisions and amending previous Oregon Plan related legislature, (creation of IMST, GWEB becomes OWEB, new funding sources, provisions for acquisitions of land, etc.). Signed and dated August 20, 1999.

Senate Bill 946

OWEB to coordinate information and data needs of natural resource agencies with the State Service Center for Geographic Information Systems. Passed by Senate June 28, 2001.

Senate Bill 945

OWEB shall submit an assessment report on the implementation and effectiveness of the Oregon plan to the Governor every odd year. Passed by Senate July 4, 2001.
