The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)

Welcome! You requested to review your student's Extended Assessment(s). Before your review begins, a few minutes will be spent reviewing the meeting guidelines.

Under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) (34 CFT Part 99) a "parent is defined as including natural parents, a guardian or an individual acting as a parent in the absence of a parent or a guardian. Only parents have the right to inspect the education records of their child." (34 CFR 99.3)

Meeting Guidelines

- The Parent Test Review Meeting will be one hour and a trained district or school employee (i.e., Qualified Assessor, Qualified Trainer) familiar with the Extended Assessment(s) to be reviewed will be present during the entire test review meeting.
- Conversation during the meeting is confidential.
- Parents must show reasonable proof that they are the student's parent(s) (and of a student who has not reached the age of majority).
- The students or other children cannot be present in the meeting room.
- Other adults such as family members and friends cannot be present in the meeting room.
- Cell phones must be turned off and out of view.
- Note or picture taking is not permitted.
