



Construction Contractors Board

Unpaid Court Judgment Filing (ORS 701.109)

This form is to be used by contractor when complying with ORS 701.109 to report unpaid court judgments.

Oregon law requires contractors to send the CCB a copy of any judgment ordering the contractor to pay damages relating to construction or proposed construction on residential construction that has not been paid or properly appealed. This requirement applies if the damages are for:

- Breach of contract
- Negligent work, or
- Improper work

The requirement includes court judgments and court orders upholding arbitration awards.

Contractors must send CCB a copy of the judgment, no more than 45 days after it is recorded unless you paid the judgment within 30 days or have appealed the judgment.
