**Governor Appoints Southern Oregon Contractor to Construction
Contractors Board (CCB)**

Governor Ted Kulongoski has appointed White City contractor Rob Hernandez to the Oregon Construction Contractors Board (CCB). Hernandez will serve as a representative from the large commercial industry.

Hernandez has been involved in the Columbia Chapter of the Associated General Contractors of America for the past eight years. "I chose to apply to the CCB to bring the experience and perspective of not only the commercial industry, but also other areas of Oregon besides Portland and the Willamette Valley," says Hernandez.

In 1995 Hernandez purchased minority ownership in S & B James Construction Company where he began his construction career. Eventually he and his partner Tom Hall purchased the business, and later formed the S & B James Construction Management Company.
