\* Maximum possible benefit for PPD, including both Impairment and Work Disability. Maximum Work Disability rating is 142 percent.

\*\* Effective Jan. 1, 2018, benefits continue for surviving children until age 19. If a child between the ages of 19 and 26 is attending higher education, they will receive monthly benefits for not more than 48 months.

HB 2337 and HB 2338, passed during the 2017 legislative session, changed minimum and maximum PTD amounts and surviving children benefits effective Jan. 1, 2018.
