Experience Rating Eligibility

A risk qualifies for experience rating on an intrastate basis when it meets the premium eligibility requirements for the state in which it operates. The eligibility amount varies by rating effective date. The ***Experience Rating Plan Manual*** should be referenced for the latest approved eligibility amounts by state and by effective date.
