10:30 a.m.	Oregon Professional Employer Organization rules and impact of HB 2800 (2025)	NCCI informed the Committee that the legislation has been enacted, and the Oregon Workers' Compensation Division will lead the rulemaking. Once the rulemaking is complete, NCCI will proceed with proposing any necessary changes to impacted <i>Basic Manual</i> rules, as may be applicable.
10:45 a.m.	New Business	 The committee representative from Liberty Mutual raised the topic of anticipated and unanticipated bonuses and their proper classification for payroll inclusion or exclusion. DCBS will review the matter and provide the Committee with a formal response. The committee representative from SAIF requested an update on the bulletin concerning union vacation pay. DCBS is drafting the bulletin and will provide the Committee with an update at the October meeting. The Chair shared background information with the Committee regarding an agent who has expressed interest in joining as the Oregon Workers' Compensation Insured representative. The Chair informed the Committee of a growing trend in audits that include payroll for independent contractors and sole proprietors who are not required to carry workers' compensation coverage.
