Hi Teri,

On behalf of the American Property Casualty Insurance Association, I wanted to follow-up on HB 3374 (SAIF MCO/subsidiaries bill) because I wanted to testify yesterday so MLAC can consider an alternative process moving forward instead of approving HB 3374 next week. Unfortunately I didn't get the opportunity to testify even though the proponents were afforded an opportunity to testify.

First, I want to thank SAIF Corporation for bringing forward an issue of providing medical services for injured workers and my client agrees that it is an issue worth solving. However, HB 3374 is not the solution.

HB 3374 deserves a longer term discussion. I would like to formally ask the committee to form a MLAC work group in the interim that brings stakeholders, MCO's and providers to craft a "system solution" instead of a "SAIF solution."

HB 3374 did not go through such a process prior to session. So please oppose HB 3374 next week and allow an MLAC work group to craft a system solution for a future legislative session. Thank you for your consideration.



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
