Overarching Review of Worker benefits – Subcommittee work - Priority

- 1. HB3374 complete with recommendations
 - A healthcare Summit is being developed and scheduled for Spring 2026.
- 2. SB705 complete with recommendations

• Workers' access to and understandability of information re: workers' compensation

- 1. Insurers and TPA's fillable 801 and/or portal to injured worker website. *Insurer*
- 2. Working with the Ombuds for Oregon Workers and Small Business to share videos and share quarterly reports. *Ongoing*
- 3. Where are the information bottlenecks? Language barriers? Demographic data to help guide info bottlenecks (21-24%) *Much discussion at the access to care subcommittee.*
- **4.** What are the problems? (Complaint box/Feedback) Length of forms are arduous. Possibly shorten and simplify the forms. **Again, much discussion at the access to care subcommittee about the administrative burden to providers can be as much as 20%.**
