FW: iLearnOregon communication to all staff- please archive



In July, staff and partners of the Department of Human Services and the Oregon Health Authority will begin to use iLearnOregon for training and for online “eLearning modules.” iLearnOregon is a new training site for our agencies and partners. We will continue to use the Learning Center through November 2016.

No action is required at this time.

Here is what to expect

On July 11, 2016, iLearnOregon will be available for DHS and OHA employees. Between mid-July and November, training announcements will direct you to register for training at either the Learning Center or iLearnOregon. iLearnOregon and the Learning Center will run simultaneously during this time. By November 2016, DHS and OHA will have completely transitioned to iLearnOregon. Your training transcripts will move to iLearnOregon in November and the Learning Center will be retired.

No action is required of you at this time. During the week of July 11, you will receive more information about the iLearnOregon migration including how to log in and where to go to search for your courses.
