**524,730 Youth were served by DHS|OHA in 2013**

Participation by number of programs

#### Medical Assistance Programs (MAP)

446,719 youth (85.1% of youth served) were eligible for MAP in 2013

- ★ MAP only = 10.9% of all youth
- ★ MAP and SNAP only = 24.7%
- ★ Three or more including MAP = 42.5%

#### Mental Health (MH)

59,814 youth (11.4% of youth served)

- ★ MH only = 0.4%
- ★ MH, MAP without SNAP = 2.4%
- ★ MH, SNAP with MAP = 8.3%

#### Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

385,977 (73.6% of youth served) received SNAP benefits during 2013

- ★ SNAP only = 6.2% of all youth
- ★ SNAP and MAP only = 24.7%
- ★ Three or more including SNAP = 40.7%

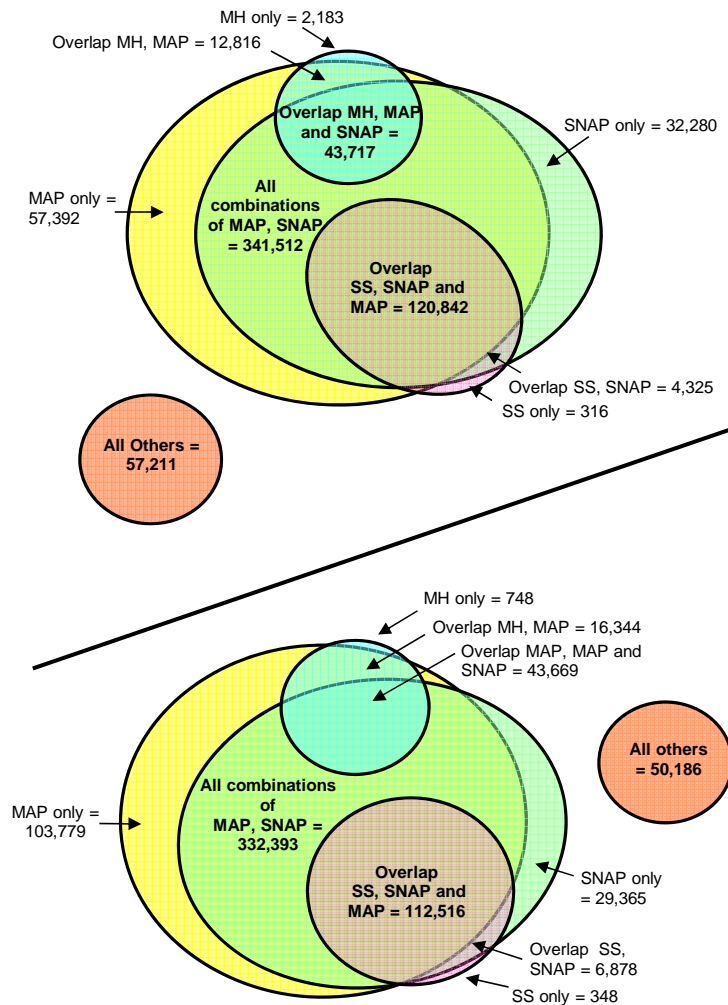
#### Self Sufficiency Programs excluding SNAP (SS)

127,057 youth (24.2% of youth served)

- ★ SS only = 0.1%
- ★ SS, SNAP without MAP = 0.8%
- ★ SS, SNAP with MAP = 23.0%

#### Medical Assistance Programs (MAP)

448,649 youth (87.4% of youth served) were eligible for MAP in 2014

- ★ MAP only = 18.7% of all youth
- ★ MAP and SNAP only = 23.7%
- ★ Three or more including MAP = 38.1%

#### Mental Health (MH)

62,460 youth (11.3% of youth served)

- ★ MH only = 0.3%
- ★ MH, SNAP without MAP = 0.1%
- ★ MH, SNAP with MAP = 7.9%

#### Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

374,983 youth (67.6% of youth served) received SNAP benefits during 2014

- ★ SNAP only = 5.3% of all youth
- ★ SNAP and MAP only = 23.7%

#### Self Sufficiency Programs excluding SNAP (SS)

121,095 youth (21.8% of youth served)

- ★ SS only = 0.1%
- ★ SS, SNAP without MAP = 1.2%
- ★ SS, SNAP with MAP = 20.3%

#### All Others

382,574 adults (45.5% of adults served) were eligible for MAP in 2013

- ★ MAP only = 5.0% of all adults
- ★ MAP and SNAP only = 15.2%
- ★ Three or more including MAP = 20.7%

#### Mental Health (MH)

106,346 adults (12.7% of adults served)

- ★ MH only = 1.4%
- ★ MH, MAP without SNAP = 1.4%
- ★ MH, SNAP with MAP = 8.4%

#### Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

654,884 (78.0% of adults served) received SNAP benefits 2013

- ★ SNAP only = 31.5% of all adults
- ★ SNAP and MAP only = 15.2%
- ★ Three or more including SNAP = 21.0%

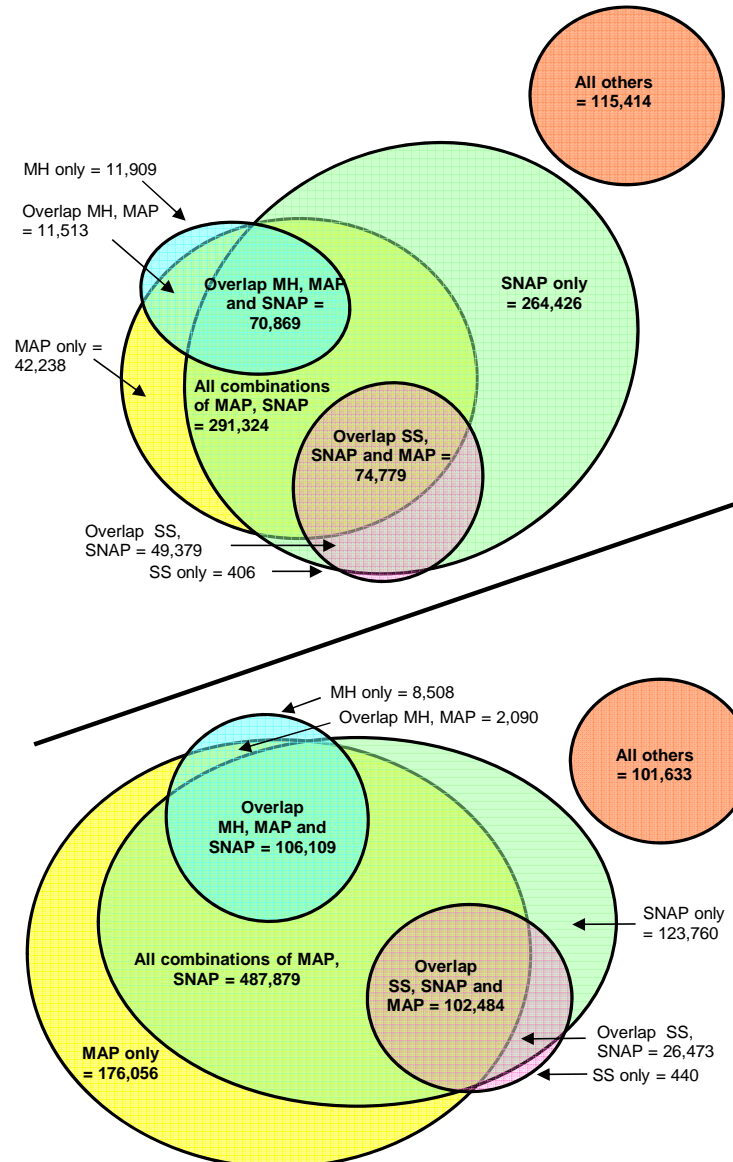

734,338 adults (76.1% of adults served) were eligible for MAP in 2014

- ★ MAP only = 18.2% of all adults
- ★ MAP and SNAP only = 26.3%
- ★ Three or more including MAP = 25.4%

#### Mental Health (MH)

141,275 adults (14.6% of adults served)

- ★ MH only = 0.9%
- ★ MH, SNAP without MAP = 0.2%
- ★ MH, SNAP with MAP = 11.0%

#### Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

651,898 (67.6% of adults served) received SNAP benefits during 2014

- ★ SNAP only = 12.8% of all adults
- ★ SNAP and MAP only = 26.3%
- ★ Three or more including SNAP = 24.6%

#### Self Sufficiency Programs excluding SNAP (SS)

131,120 adults (10.5% of adults served)

- ★ SS only < 0.1%
- ★ SS, SNAP without MAP = 2.7%
- ★ SS, SNAP with MAP = 10.6%

829,293 people (60.8% of people served) were eligible for MAP in 2013

- ★ MAP only = 7.3% of all people
- ★ MAP and SNAP only = 18.9%
- ★ Three or more including MAP = 29.0%

### Mental Health (MH)

166,160 people (12.2% of people served)

- ★ MH only = 1.0%
- ★ MH, MAP without SNAP = 1.8%
- ★ MH, SNAP with MAP = 8.4%

### Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

1,040,861 people (76.3% of people served) received SNAP benefits during 2013

- ★ SNAP only = 21.7% of all people
- ★ SNAP and MAP only = 18.9%
- ★ Three or more including SNAP = 28.6%

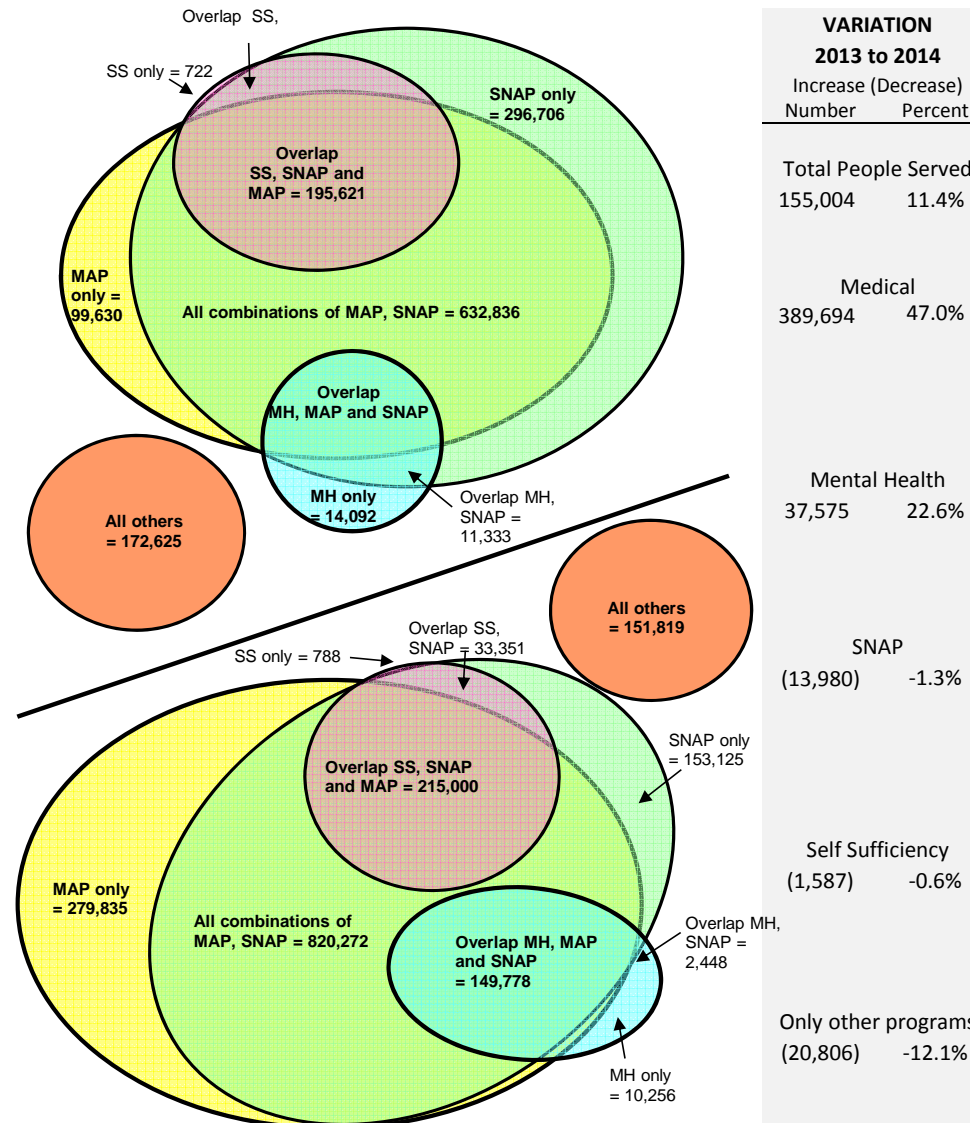

1,218,987 people (80.2% of people served) were eligible for MAP in 2014

- ★ MAP only = 18.4% of all people
- ★ MAP and SNAP only = 25.4%
- ★ Three or more including MAP = 30.0%

### Mental Health (MH)

203,735 people (13.4% of people served)

- ★ MH only = 0.7%
- ★ MH, MAP without SNAP = 2.7%
- ★ MH, MAP with SNAP = 9.9%

### Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

1,026,881 people (67.6% of people served) received SNAP benefits during 2014

- ★ SNAP only = 10.1% of all people
- ★ SNAP and MAP only = 25.4%
- ★ Three or more including SNAP = 29.0%

### Self Sufficiency Programs excluding SNAP (SS)

252,215 people (16.6% of people served)

- ★ SS only = 0.1%
- ★ SS, SNAP without MAP = 2.2%
