Medical Assistance Programs (MAP)

718,325 people (64.3% of all people) were eligible for MAP in March 2013

- ★ MAP only = 11.3% of all people
- ★ MAP and SNAP only = 24.7%
- ★ Three or more including MAP = 22.4%

Mental Health (MH)

81,540 people (7.3% of all people)

- ★ MH only = 0.9%
- ★ MH, MAP without SNAP = 1.5%
- ★ MH, MAP with SNAP = 4.4%

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

808,015 (72.4% of all people) received SNAP benefits during March 2013

- ★ SNAP only = 21.3% of all people
- ★ SNAP and MAP only = 24.7%
- ★ Three or more including SNAP = 21.6%

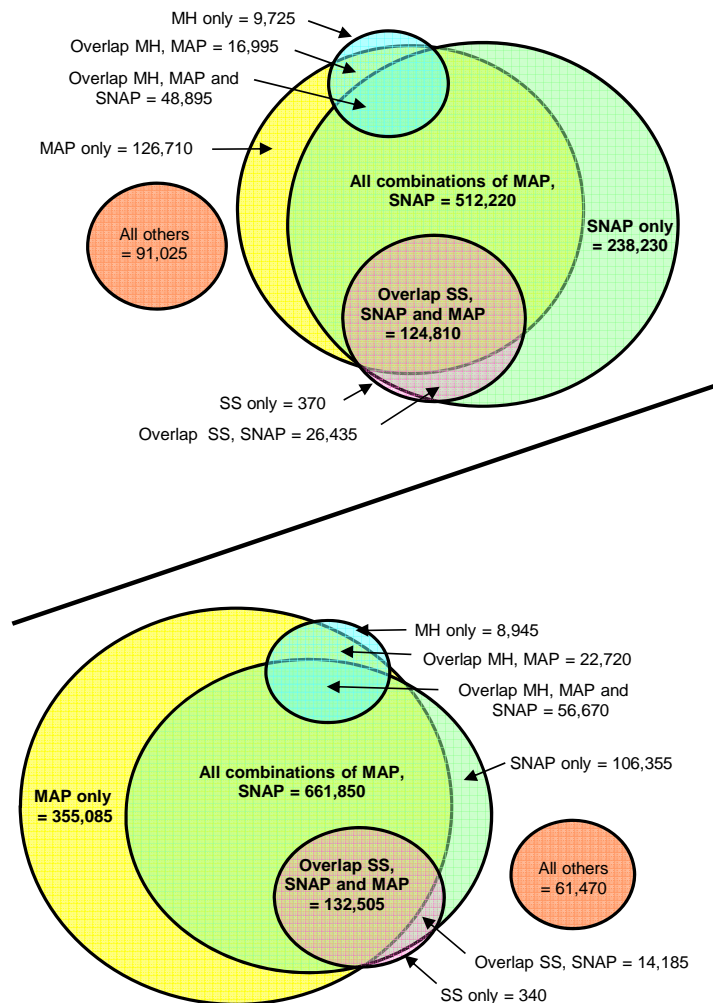
Self Sufficiency Programs excluding SNAP (SS)

90,435 people (6.8% of all people)

- ★ MH only = 0.7%

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

791,830 (59.9% of all people) received SNAP benefits during March 2014

- ★ SNAP only = 8.0% of all people
- ★ SNAP and MAP only = 30.1%
- ★ Three or more including SNAP = 20.1%

Self Sufficiency Programs excluding SNAP (SS)

151,445 people (11.5% of all people)

- ★ SS only < 0.1%
- ★ SS, SNAP without MAP = 1.1%

499,510 (75.4% of all adults) received SNAP benefits March 2013

- ★ SNAP only = 32.1% of all adults

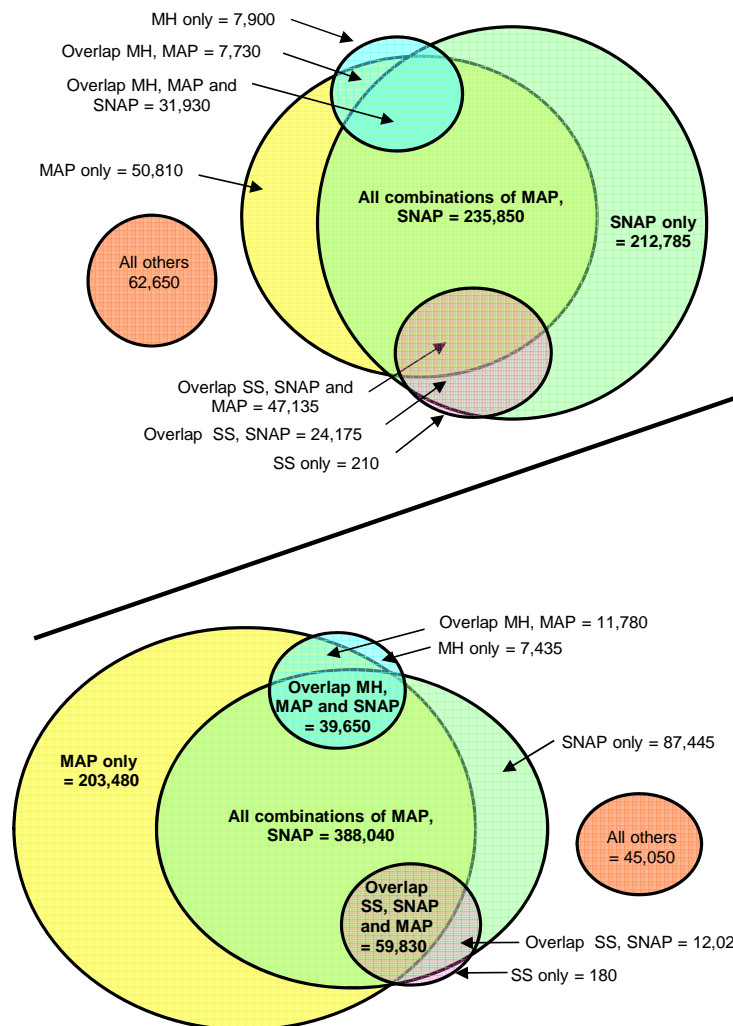

Mental Health (MH)

60,605 adults (7.5% of all adults)

- ★ MH only = 0.9%
- ★ MH, MAP without SNAP = 1.5%
- ★ MH, MAP with SNAP = 4.9%

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

494,615 (61.1% of all adults) received SNAP benefits during March 2014

- ★ SNAP only = 10.8% of all adults
- ★ SNAP and MAP only = 31.2%
- ★ Three or more including SNAP = 16.8%

74,430 adults (9.2% of all adults)

- ★ SS only < 0.1%

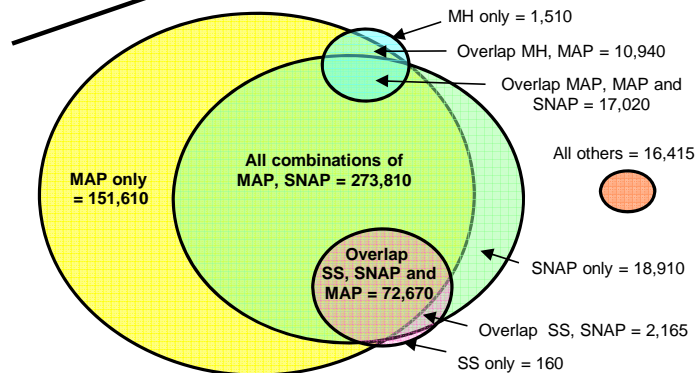
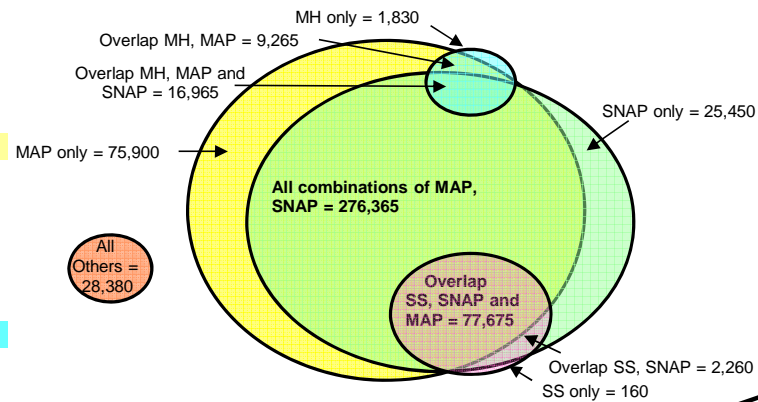

- ★ Three or more including MAP = 26.8%

Mental Health (MH)

29,830 youth (5.8% of all youth)

- ★ MH only = 0.3%
- ★ MH, MAP without SNAP = 2.1%
- ★ MH, MAP with SNAP = 3.3%

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

297,220 youth (58.0% of all youth) received SNAP benefits during March 2014

- ★ SNAP only = 3.7% of all youth
- ★ SNAP and MAP only = 28.2%
- ★ Three or more including SNAP = 25.3%

Self Sufficiency Programs excluding SNAP (SS)

77,015 youth (15.0% of all youth)

- ★ SS only < 0.1%
- ★ SS, SNAP without MAP = 0.4%
- ★ SS, SNAP with MAP = 14.2%
