JOBS is the state's employment and training program for people on public assistance.



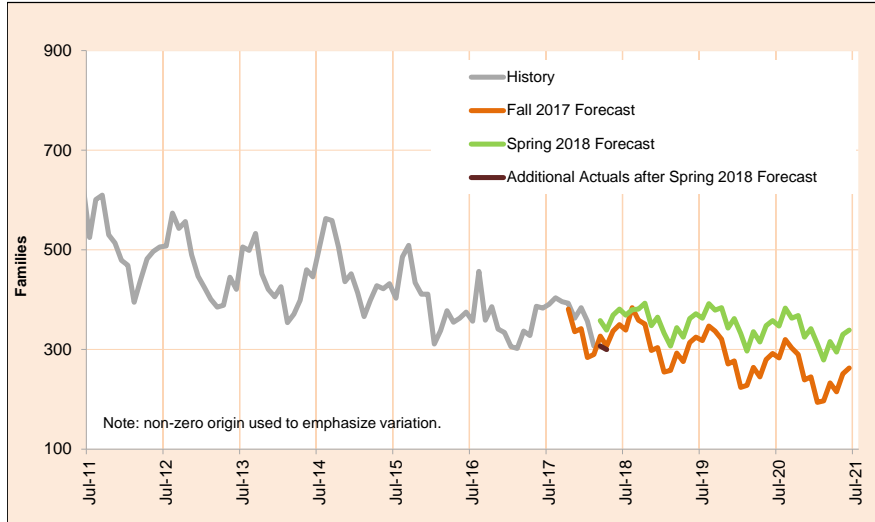
