

CCA Mandatory Abuse Reporter Training

Office of Adult Abuse Prevention & Investigations (OAAPI)

Why: Senate Bill 1515 Section 37(2) (b) mandates that Child Caring Agencies (CCA) provide an annual training and written materials to employees of the CCA and any employees of any proctor foster home certified by the CCA. In the spirit of collaboration, OAAPI has taken the first steps in moving this important training forward.

Per OAR 407-045-0800, the Office of Adult Abuse Prevention and Investigations (OAAPI) has the responsibility to investigate reports of child abuse in CCA's in which the CCA, CCA employees, proctor foster home provider or their staff, is reported to be responsible.

A Child Caring Agency for the purpose of this training includes the following:

- Children's residential care agencies
- Day treatment programs
- Therapeutic boarding schools
- Foster care agencies; and
- Outdoor youth programs

What: OAAPI is providing multiple training events which will educate and advise the CCA and employees on abuse rule definitions, mandatory reporting, the investigative process, and due process.

When: The training will be offered via Netlink which allows individuals to attend a live class over the internet.
