RE: Sheltered workshop settings – UPDATED April 1, 2019
DATE: April 1, 2019

All or a portion of the settings on the enclosed list are considered to be Sheltered Workshop settings as defined under Oregon Administrative Rule 407-025 and Oregon's Executive Order 15-01, or support individuals who are doing Sheltered Work. This list is current as of April 1, 2019, and updates the original version posted on June 29, 2015.

In Oregon, a Sheltered Workshop means:

“[A] facility in which individuals with I/DD are congregated for the purpose of receiving employment services and performing work tasks for pay at the facility. A sheltered workshop primarily employs individuals with I/DD and other disabilities, with the exception of service support staff. A sheltered workshop is a fixed site that is owned, operated, or controlled by a provider, where an individual has few or no opportunities to interact with non-disabled individuals, except paid support staff. A sheltered workshop is not small group employment in an integrated employment setting, and is not otherwise an integrated employment setting as defined in this rule.”

Effective July 1, 2015, no new participants are permitted to use ODDS services for support in a Sheltered Workshop setting. For individuals who are already using services for support in a Sheltered Workshop setting, the only service that may be used in this setting is Employment Path Facility.

A portion of a provider's address or site listed on the enclosure meets the definition of a Sheltered Workshop. However, this does not necessarily mean that the entire site or address is a Sheltered Workshop. Individuals may continue to be referred to use other services in settings that are not the Sheltered Workshop setting.

In addition to those settings outlined below, there may be no new referrals to use ODDS services to complete work (such as document destruction, janitorial, assembly, production, etc.) for pay in a group setting at a provider

site. Please contact ODDS if you have any questions about whether a setting is a Sheltered Workshop setting. Please also see policy transmittals 15-006, 15-007, and 15-022 for additional details.
