

# RESIDENTIAL CARE FACILITIES IN OREGON

Provide daily meals and snacks, assistance with personal care, health monitoring and supervision, medication administration, and care coordination; are staffed 24-hour daily; and have private or shared apartments and bathrooms.

The Oregon Department of Human Services licenses and monitors RCFs.

There were 272 residential care facilities with a capacity for 10,435 residents in 2014. A total of 146 of these facilities were also endorsed to provide memory care.

84% for-profit

58% managed by a third-party agency

Residential care facility ownership

- 38% under a single ownership
- 39% part of a 2-25 facility chain
- 23% part of a 26+ facility chain

Unit types

- 41% studio units
- 50% one-bedroom units



Payment sources

- 55% of residents paid with private resources
- 32% of residents were Medicaid clients

Private pay rates

- 76% of residents paid less than \$3999/month
- 8% of residents paid \$4000-4999/month
- 16% of residents paid over \$5000/month


