Arbitration Fees:

Per diem fee: \$1000. A hearing day is any portion of a day up to eight hours. Time for communications, research, preparation, award, and for a hearing day beyond eight hours, is prorated at \$150./hr.

Cancellation Policy: If a scheduled hearing is canceled with notice of less than three calendar weeks (21 days), the per diem fee shall be charged for each scheduled day. Postponements require similar notice or charge one day per diem fee.

Travel Time: Arbitrator charges per diem fee for any portion of a travel day up to eight hours, excluding any travel time less than two hours, and any outside of Oregon.

Expenses: Arbitrator charges actual cost of reasonable expenses, including transportation, food and lodging, excluding any incurred outside of Oregon. Automobile mileage is charged at the applicable IRS expense rate.
