Subject: Modified License Parameters (Revised)

Below is a recap of the parameters regarding a new modified license:

- One-year landscape related experience qualification requirement
- Licensee must be the owner of the business
- \$5,000 job limit (per jobsite, per customer, per year). An increase to \$6,500 may be allowed after 24 months without a claim filed or civil penalty issued
- Must pass laws, rules, and business practice section of the exam (ORS 671.570(1)(d) requires an exam)
- No piercing of the dwelling
- Subcontracting would be allowed

There are no concerns from the other agencies regarding the current exemptions for tree work, low voltage and backflow work.

ORS 671.560(4)(a) allows the Board to issue limited or specialty licenses.

A hearing for the rule will be held on December 6, 2018 at 9:00 am at the Keizer Community Center, 930 Chemawa Road NE, Keizer, OR.

Rule comment period will close December 14, 2018.
