Notice is hereby given that the Oregon Department of Land Conservation & Development (DLCD), as provided in Section 307(c) of the Coastal Zone Management Act, is reviewing the following federal action for consistency with the Oregon Coastal Management Program:

PROPOSED FEDERAL ACTION: The proposed action consists of placing the 1.28 acre property into federal trust status on behalf of the Tolowa Tribe. Proposed land use consists of multi-family residential housing. The project consists of 1 two-story building, which will provide 6 affordable housing units for tribal members.

- State Authorities incorporated into the Oregon Coastal Management Program (e.g., Removal-Fill Law, Water Quality Standards, Fish & Wildlife Regulations), as applicable.
