RE: CIAC Report to LCCD

Work is in progress in developing a new Work Plan for the 2011-13 biennium. Items on the current work plan have been completed, except for those that are of an ongoing nature, such as finding improved technological means to conduct meetings without travel. Included in the discussion of a new work plan is the idea of meeting with LCDC and the Local Officials Advisory Committee on specific issues related to citizen involvement. We will be reporting to you more about the work plan as it is further refined.

CIAC members report that they are participating in the DLCD rulemaking committees: irrigation ponds, solar and greenhouse gas targets. The members feel that it is working well to have a CIAC member representing citizens on these rulemaking committees.

We would also like to report that at nearly every meeting a member of the public attends to ask for assistance with a grievance about the citizen involvement process in a local land use planning process. CIAC provides suggestions and referral to resources.
