RE: **Notice of Public Hearing and Possible Adoption of Temporary Administrative Rules Regarding Measure 49**

The Land Conservation and Development Commission (LCDC) will be considering the adoption of temporary administrative rules intended to specify the procedures for supplemental review of Measure 37 claims under Measure 49 (Chapter 424, Oregon Laws 2007). In addition, LCDC will consider minor changes to existing temporary rules implementing Measure 49. This proposed rulemaking also addresses the effect of 2007 Ballot Measure 49 on waivers that have already been approved by DLCD under 2004 Ballot Measure 37, including the effect for purposes of the state agency coordination requirements under ORS 197.180. Finally, the proposed temporary rules also concern the delegation to the director of the responsibilities and authorities of the Commission in responding to claims under Ballot Measure 49. The proposed temporary rules are in OAR 660, divisions 2 and 41.

LCDC will hold a public hearing to consider the proposed temporary rules, described above, at a special meeting scheduled February 12, 2008, at 2:30 p.m., in the State of Oregon Agriculture Building, Conference Room D, 635 Capitol St. NE, Salem. Interested persons may address the Commission concerning the proposed temporary rules at this public hearing, or may provide written comments in advance or at the hearing. Comments will be accepted until the close of the hearing. If adopted, the temporary rules will be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State in accordance with ORS 183.325(5).
