In looking at this last set of minutes, I want to echo the comment made by Jim Tierney. Please don't let the task force lose sight of the fact that small cities might be affected differently, or have a different economic framework than larger cities. Sisters is primarily tourist and recreation oriented. We have many service oriented jobs here that do not pay a lot, and they are seasonal in nature.

We'd certainly be interested in being considered for a pilot project if that idea evolves on the task force. I think our Housing Plan consultant, Susanna Julber, might have already relayed this sentiment.
