Legislative Update- January 27, 2009  
Oregon Mortuary & Cemetery Board

### Overall Dates and Deadlines

- February 2 – Last day to request draft bills from Legislative Counsel
- February 23 – Daily floor sessions begin in the House and Senate
- March 2 – Last day for bills to be introduced in the House and Senate
- April 17 – Last day for House committees to post agendas for work sessions on House Bills and Senate committees to post agendas for work sessions on Senate Bills
- April 28 – Last day for House committees to hold work sessions on House Bills and Senate committees to hold work sessions on Senate Bills
- May 20 – Last day for House committees to post agendas for work sessions on Senate Bills and Senate committees to post agendas for work sessions on House Bills
- May 28 – Last day for House committees to hold work sessions on Senate Bills and Senate committees to hold work sessions on House Bills
- June 30 – Last day to adjourn Sine Die

Within those dates and deadlines, the committee agenda posting requirements are as follows:

- House Committees – 72 hours notice for first public hearing; 48 hours notice for all other meetings
- Senate Committees – 48 hours notice for all meetings

According to rules, House and Senate committees are also required to have fiscal and revenue impacts prepared by LFO and LRO on **all** bills and amendments **before** the bill is moved out of committee.

Agencies will be required to respond to requests for potential fiscal impact for any related bills and for all state wide bills that are introduced. Notification and response window may be less than one business day depending on committee schedule.
