The Oregon Mortuary and Cemetery Board (Board) issued a Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action on June 20, 2006 against the Respondent in Case No. 06-1010B. This Notice was amended on May 14, 2008 (Amended Notice) and the Amended Notice is hereby incorporated by reference. The Respondent timely requested a hearing. This Consent Order constitutes the final resolution of this contested case proceeding.

The parties therefore agree as follows:

Respondent hereby withdraws the request for hearing and waives any and all rights to further hearing, appeal or other legal challenge to this Consent Order.

Respondent hereby acknowledges that it has read, understands, and agrees to the terms of this Consent Order.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Board finds the facts alleged in the Amended Notice to be true.

2. Respondent shall pay to the Board civil penalties in the amount of \$3,000.00 for allowing violations of ORS 692.025(1) and OAR 830-030-0004(1); and for violating OAR 830-030-0090(2)(d)(B); OAR 830-040-0050(5); OAR 830-030-0100(9); OAR 830-040-0000(6)(g); and ORS 692.180(1)(a) and (b). Respondent shall tender payment of the civil penalties upon execution of this Consent Order.

3. This Consent Order shall become effective when signed by the Executive Director of the Board.
