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WHEREAS, the Oregon State Mortuary and Cemetery Board (Board) is prepared to issue a Notice of Proposed Denial of Preneed Salesperson Registration Certificate against Breana Riddle (hereafter "Applicant") in Case No. 11-1062 upon the following bases:

1. On November 18 2011, the Board received a completed application from Applicant for a Preneed Salesperson Registration Certificate. In the application, Applicant failed to disclose her criminal history. Applicant was arrested on July 12, 1981 for Driving While Suspended-Misdemeanor by the Lake Oswego Police Department. Applicant was convicted on September 9, 1982 by the Lake Oswego Municipal Court.
2. The foregoing are misrepresentations on an application by not disclosing an arrest and a conviction for Driving While Suspended-Misdemeanor, and are therefore grounds for refusal to grant a Preneed Salesperson Registration Certificate pursuant to ORS 692.180(1)(a) and (g) and ORS 97.931(3)(a).

WHEREAS, the Board and the Applicant are desirous of resolving and settling the foregoing matters in Case No. 11-1062 without further proceedings thereon and this Consent Order constitutes the entire agreement of the parties and is a final order of the Board, the Board and Applicant agree to the following:

1. Applicant is aware of the right to a hearing with the assistance of counsel and the right to judicial review of the Board's decision in Case No. 11-1062, and hereby freely and voluntarily waives those rights;

2. Applicant hereby acknowledges that she has read, understands, and agrees to the terms of this Consent Order;
3. For violating OAR 830-030-0090(5)(d), OAR 830-030-0090(5)(g), OAR 830-050-0050(2) and ORS 692.180(1)(a) upon the effective date of this Consent Order, Applicant is placed on probation for at least twenty-four months, subject to the following conditions:
 - a. Applicant will comply with all laws and rules applicable to the death care industry.
 - b. Applicant will notify the Board, in writing, anytime her employer or employers change.
 - c. Applicant will provide a complete copy of this Consent Order to her current death care industry employer and to any other death care industry employer in Oregon that employs Applicant during the period of probation.
 - d. Applicant will provide six-month Reports from each employer regarding her conduct. Each Report must be received by the Board within ten days following the end of the six month period which will commence on the date of this Consent Order, and must include at a minimum:
 - i. The name and signature of Applicant's supervisor;
 - ii. Whether Applicant remains employed at this facility. If Applicant is no longer employed, the Report must provide the date Applicant was last employed and the reason for her departure; and
 - iii. Whether Applicant has received any discipline from the employer during the quarter. The Report must state the nature of the discipline and the reason for such discipline.
4. If at any time during the prescribed probationary period, Applicant violates any provision of this Order, or any provision of ORS Chapter 692 or OAR Chapter 830, the Board may revoke all licenses held by Applicant.
5. The Board shall determine satisfactory completion of the Applicant's probation based upon the Applicant's successful completion of the probationary period, criminal background checks and any other relevant information.
6. This Consent Order shall become effective when signed by the Executive Director of the Board.
