

OBCE Record Keeping CE and examples of what your renewal may look like.

The 2016 CE Requirement for DCs: Two (2) hours record keeping. ALL licensees MUST submit proof of their compliance sometime during 2016 and definitely by December 31, 2016.

Situation 1:

I am a Senior Active licensee, and today is August 1, 2015. I just finished a six-hour CE course to report at my January 2016 Renewal; I only need six hours annually. Do I have to complete the Board's mandated Two (2) hours CE before I can renew in January 2016? **No. Renew as you planned AND** in the following months (and before December 31, 2016) complete the two hours Record Keeping CE and expect to report them at your following renewal period (January 2017) with your other general CE credits.

Situation 2:

I am maintaining an Inactive license, do I need to complete these mandatory two hours CE in record keeping? **No. This is a requirement for DCs maintaining an Active license ONLY.**

Situation 3:

I am a newly licensed doctor and my license is not due to be renewed until October 2016. I was informed that new licensees need to only complete six hours CE total their first year of licensure (4 hours in over-the-counter substances, and the 2 hours in evidence-based outcomes assessment). Do I need to complete the two hours in Record Keeping? **No, you do not need to complete the additional hours.** New DCs renewing in Oregon for the first time are exempt.

Situation 4:

It is November 2016. I have been maintaining my license as inactive the past two years and now this month I want to change my status to active. I already have 20 hours CE complete in order to change my status, do I need to have the additional two hours in recordkeeping – prior to changing my status? **Yes, you will need the additional two hours prior to activating your 2016 license.**
