





Pesticide Advisory

Alert – Plantlife Products' The Hammer product contains naphthaleneacetic acid

July 21, 2016

The Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA) has reason to believe the product The Hammer, manufactured by Plantlife Products, contains a pesticide active ingredient, naphthaleneacetic acid, not listed on the label. ODA's advisory is based on Washington State Department of Agriculture's (WSDA) laboratory testing and confirmation of undeclared pesticide active ingredients. ODA is currently undergoing sampling and testing of this product in Oregon.

Use of The Hammer could cause cannabis to fail Oregon Health Authority (OHA) pesticide testing requirements. Growers of all crops and retailers are advised to discontinue using or selling The Hammer until further notice.
