



Pesticide Advisory

Alert – Van de Uber Marketing and Manufacturing’s Pyyro K 0-3-7 product contains paclobutrazol

July 21, 2016

The Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA) has reason to believe the product Pyyro K 0-3-7, manufactured by Van de Uber Marketing and Manufacturing, contains a pesticide active ingredient, paclobutrazol, not listed on the label. ODA’s advisory is based on Washington State Department of Agriculture’s (WSDA) laboratory testing and confirmation of undeclared pesticide active ingredients. ODA is currently undergoing sampling and testing of this product in Oregon.

Use of Pyyro K 0-3-7 could cause cannabis to fail Oregon Health Authority (OHA) pesticide testing requirements. Growers of all crops and retailers are advised to discontinue using or selling Pyyro K 0-3-7 until further notice.
