

# Sorry, pets are not allowed.

Oregon law prohibits **all** animals except for service animals in grocery stores, restaurants, and other food establishments.



**Service animals are trained working animals, NOT pets.**

- The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) defines a service animal as a **dog** that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for a person with a disability.
- Dogs or therapy animals whose function is to provide comfort or emotional support **do not** qualify as service animals according to the ADA, even with a doctor's note.
