## When is testing required?

The following requirements apply to hemp and hemp products used for human:

- Application to skin or hair
- Eating or drinking\*
- Inhalation

No post-harvest testing required if the product is:

- Hemp seed for food
- Bulk plant material not used for applications to skin or hair, food or drinks, or inhalation

Product Type	Testing Requirement
Usable hemp Includes flower/buds and pre-rolls  (30 lb batches)	<ul><li>Pesticides</li><li>Water activity &amp; moisture content</li><li>THC/CBD</li></ul>
Bulk plant material for further processing Handler wants to qualify for pesticide remediation  (30 lb batches)	Will use sterilization method:  • Pesticides Will not use sterilization method:  • Pesticides  • Water activity & moisture content
Handler <i>does not want to qualify</i> for pesticide remediation  (30 lb batches)	Will use sterilization method:  No testing  Will not use sterilization method:  Water activity & moisture content
Extract or concentrate for further processing  (Per batch)	<ul> <li>Pesticides</li> <li>Solvents</li> <li>Exempt from solvent testing if a solvent was not used.<sup>1</sup></li> </ul>
Extract or concentrate for retail  (Per batch)	<ul> <li>Pesticides</li> <li>Solvents</li> <li>Exempt from solvent testing if a solvent was not used.<sup>1</sup></li> <li>THC/CBD</li> </ul>
Cannabinoid hemp product  Edibles or any product intended for human consumption. Includes hemp topicals, transdermal patches and inhalation (e.g. vape pens).	• THC/CBD
Cannabinoid hemp product For non hemp handlers Edibles or any product intended for human consumption. Includes hemp topicals, transdermal patches and inhalation (e.g. vape pens).	<ul> <li>A final product does not require testing if:         <ul> <li>you are not a hemp handler, and</li> <li>you can show the hemp ingredient going into your product has a full compliance test result at or below 0.3% total THC.<sup>2</sup></li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Note: Testing must be completed by an ORELAP accredited and OLCC licensed laboratory.
