Camping Fee Increases

Oregon Department of Forestry has increased the fees in campgrounds and designated camping areas. The fee increase was necessary due to the increase in operational costs and it is the first price increase in 20 years.

Oregon State Forests offer a wide variety of camping options. Please visit Oregon.gov/ODF for camping information.

NEW CAMPING RULES

Oregon Administrative Rules Revised 2016

- A campsite may not be occupied by more than 8 people & two motor vehicles unless otherwise posted. *Make sure your group is the right size for the campsite!*
- The registered camper must physically occupy the campsite each night during the entire length of stay. *No reserving sites! You must camp in your site every night.*
- A person must be 18 years of age or older to register for a campsite. *Don't leave your minor to hold a site.*
- Where toilet facilities are provided, a person may not dispose of human waste except in those facilities. *Use the restrooms provided!*
- If no restrooms are provided, a person may not deposit human waste within 100 feet of any campsite, trail or body of water. Human waste must be buried to a depth of at least 6 inches. *You must clean up after your pet too!*
