REQUEST FOR CONTRACTOR SPECIAL PREQUALIFICATION FOR
2018 CATHODIC PROTECTION PROJECTS

The Oregon Department of Transportation is seeking Contractor Special Prequalification (CSP) submittals from Contractors desiring to bid on one or more of the following Cathodic Protection projects:

Number	Project Name	Bid Opening Date
1	US101:Devils Lake Outlet, Schooner Creek & Slitcoos River Bridges	May 10, 2018
2	US101: Cathodic Protection and Concrete Repairs	August 9, 2018

The primary purpose of these Projects is to rehabilitate and preserve the structures by repairing reinforced concrete components damaged by corrosion and installing an impressed current cathodic protection system or replacing an aged cathodic protection system for reinforced concrete components above the ordinary high water line. Additional work on the Projects may include removing and replacing the existing bridge rail, strengthening bridge elements, installing seismic restraints, installing a deck overlay, installing or replacing expansion joints, and installing or replacing bridge drains.

The project cost range value is preliminary, may not reflect the current scope of the project, and is not a reflection of the Engineer's Estimate. The Project Cost estimate ranges are as follows:

2	US101: Cathodic Protection and Concrete Repairs	\$20,000,000-30,000,000

Bids will only be accepted from Contractors who have received written notification from ODOT that they have passed the Contractor Special Prequalification evaluation. Contractors passing the Contractor Special Prequalification will also be required to prequalify under the ODOT Prime Contractor Prequalification process, if they have not already done so, at least ten (10) days prior to bid opening. (See Contractor Special Prequalification Package for information regarding the ODOT Prime Contractor Prequalification process.)

Contractors that pass the Contractor Special Prequalification may also be required to become TERO certified to successfully bid on one or more of the identified projects. Check the actual project Special Provisions bid document for TERO requirements.
