Requested Action

Request approval to adopt the Interstate 5 Exit 21 Interchange Area Management Plan (IAMP) as an amendment to the Oregon Highway Plan and adopt the findings of compliance in support of this action, located in Attachment 3.

Background

Coordinating closely with the City of Talent and Jackson County, the Oregon Department of Transportation developed an Interchange Area Management Plan to protect the function of the Talent Interchange (Interstate 5, Exit 21) in Jackson County, Oregon near the City of Talent. The IAMP assesses transportation needs and identifies facility improvements. A notice of intent to adopt and a copy of the IAMP were sent to the City of Talent, Jackson County, Rogue Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization and the Department of Land Conservation and Development on July 21, 2016.
