**Oregon Transportation Commission
2016 Report to the Oregon Legislature:
Unused Funds from the 2009 Jobs and Transportation Act (JTA)**

The 2009 Oregon Legislature passed the Jobs and Transportation Act (JTA). The JTA identified 37 specific projects and allocated funding to 12 local governments in eastern Oregon, for a total of 51 projects.

Oregon Laws 2012, Chapter 55 requires the Oregon Transportation Commission to submit a report by November 1 of each year to the interim legislative transportation committees identifying funding available as a result of completing projects for less than amounts allocated in the JTA. The Oregon Transportation Commission must provide the interim transportation committees with a prioritized list of projects that require additional funding to be completed.

No projects that have been completed since the last report have funds remaining. All projects are projected to have adequate funds to complete them.
