Amateur (HAM) Radio Operator

- You must have a valid amateur radio license.
- These plates are not available at DMV offices. If you apply at an office you may get a temporary permit to use until you receive plates in the mail.

- If you also need a title, follow the [title instructions](#); otherwise, complete a [Registration Application](#).

Antique

- Any vehicle that can be registered may get antique registration if it is:
 - Maintained as a collector's item; and
 - Older than half the number of years between the current year and 1900.

- Antique registration is permanent and only one plate is issued.
- These plates are not available at DMV offices. If you apply at an office you may get a temporary permit to use until you receive plates in the mail.
- If you also need a title, follow the [title instructions](#); otherwise, complete a [Registration Application](#).

Bus

This plate style is for commercial vehicles with a registration weight over 8,000 pounds designed and used to carry passengers with their baggage and express for compensation or a vehicle with a registration weight of more than 10,000 pounds that is primarily used to carry passengers.

- If your bus is **over 26,000 pounds** you need to contact [Motor Carrier](#); if the vehicle can be registered with DMV you will need to complete a [Registration Certification](#).
- If your bus does not have to be registered with Motor Carrier and has a taxable gross weight of 55,000 pounds or more you must provide a copy of the Heavy Vehicle Use Tax Return ([IRS Form 2290](#)).
- A Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) [Certificate of Compliance](#) may be required if you are in a DEQ area.
- These plates are not available at DMV offices. If you apply at an office you may get a temporary permit to use until you receive plates in the mail.
- Registration is valid for the amount of quarters you apply for, up to one year.
- If you also need a title, follow the [title instructions](#); otherwise, complete a [Registration Application](#).

Camper

A camper is a structure with facilities for human habitation or camping that is 6 feet or longer and 5 ½ feet or higher from floor to ceiling (when fully extended) that has a floor designed to be mounted upon a motor vehicle but not permanently attached.

- This plate is available at DMV offices and by mail. The plate can be [customized](#) using letters or numbers of your choice for an additional fee.
- Registration is valid for two years.
- If you also need a title, follow the [title instructions](#); otherwise, complete a [Registration Application](#).

Disabled Veteran

These plates cannot be used to park in Disabled Person Parking spaces.

- A qualifying veteran can only have one plate or set of plates. Any vehicle that can be registered may get disabled veteran plates **except**:
 - Low-speed;
 - Medium-speed; and
 - Commercial vehicles.
- Disabled Veteran registration is permanent.
- You must provide proof that you have a service-connected disability.
- An [Application for Disabled Veteran Plates](#) is required.
- These plates are not available at DMV offices. If you apply at an office you may get a temporary permit to use until you receive plates in the mail.
- If you also need a title, follow the [title instructions](#); otherwise, complete a [Registration Application](#).

Ex-POW

Ex-POW registration is permanent. Only one motor vehicle per qualifying veteran per household can have Ex-POW plates. These plates are not available at DMV offices. If you apply at an office you may get a temporary permit to use until you receive plates in the mail. Any motor vehicle that can be registered may get Ex-POW plates **except**:

- Low-speed;
- Medium-speed;
- Vehicles with a combined or loaded weight over 10,000 pounds; and
- Commercial vehicles.

To qualify you must:

- Provide proof of your qualifying POW status; and
- Submit an [Ex-POW Certification](#) with your [title](#) or [registration application](#).

Farm

This plate style is for qualifying motorized farm vehicles.

- You must have a U.S. DOT number; if you need one call 800-832-5660.
- You must get farm approval from [Motor Carrier](#).
- If you do not already have farm plates on the vehicle, you must submit a [Farm Application](#) with your application.
- If the vehicle has a taxable gross weight of 55,000 pounds or more you must provide a copy of the Heavy Vehicle Use Tax Return ([IRS Form 2290](#)).
- These plates are not usually available at DMV offices. If you apply at an office, you may get a temporary permit to use until the plates arrive in the mail. Registration is valid for the amount of quarters you apply for, up to one year.
- If you also need a title, follow the [title instructions](#); otherwise, complete a [Registration Application](#).

Heavy Trailer

A heavy trailer has a loaded weight over 8,000 pounds (except for travel trailers, fixed loads and special use trailers). A vehicle towing a heavy trailer must be registered by weight. If your vehicle has passenger plates, you can get a [Registration Weight Trip Permit](#) to use while towing the heavy trailer.

- The registration is permanent.
- These plates are available at DMV offices and by mail.
- If you also need a title, follow the [title instructions](#); otherwise, complete a [Registration Application](#).

Moped

A moped has an independent power source that has an engine size of 50 cubic centimeters or less or rotor displacement of 3.05 cubic inches or less **and** does not exceed 30 miles per hour; if either of those statements is not true for your bike, it's a motorcycle.

- This plate is available at DMV offices and by mail. The plate can be [customized](#) using letters or numbers of your choice for an additional fee.
- Registration is valid for four years for a brand new moped or two years for any other moped.
- If you also need a title, follow the [title instructions](#); otherwise, complete a [Registration Application](#).

Motor Home

A motor home is a motorized vehicle that is designed to provide facilities for human habitation.

- These plates are available at DMV offices and by mail. These plates can be [customized](#) using letters or numbers of your choice for an additional fee.
- A Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) [Certificate of Compliance](#) may be required if you are in a DEQ area.
- Registration is valid for two years.
- If you also need a title, follow the [title instructions](#); otherwise, complete a [Registration Application](#).

National Guard – Motor Home

- You must provide proof that you are an active member of the Oregon National Guard by submitting an Oregon Military Certificate of Eligibility, AGO Form 4309.
 - You can contact your unit commander to get Form 4309.
- These plates are not available at DMV offices. If you apply at an office you may get a temporary permit to use until you receive plates in the mail.
- If you also need a title, follow the [title instructions](#); otherwise, complete a [Registration Application](#).

Snowmobile

A snowmobile must be titled and registered even if you only use it on your own property (there are a few exceptions, see [ORS 821.070 and ORS 821.090](#)).

- This decal is available at DMV offices and by mail.
- Registration is valid for two years.
- If you also need a title, follow the [title instructions](#); otherwise, complete a [Registration Application](#).

Special Interest

- Your vehicle must be maintained as a collector’s item; and
- Your vehicle must be one of the following:
 - At least 25 years old;
 - Sanctioned as Special Interest;
 - A street rod;
 - A high-mobility multipurpose wheeled vehicle (HMMWV); or
 - A racing activity vehicle.
- Special Interest registration is permanent and only one plate is issued.
- These plates are not available at DMV offices. If you apply at an office you may get a temporary permit to use until you receive plates in the mail.
- You must submit a [Special Interest Vehicle Declaration](#).
- If you also need a title, follow the [title instructions](#); otherwise, complete a [Registration Application](#).

Travel Trailer

A travel trailer is a trailer that provides facilities for human habitation and is designed to be used temporarily for recreational, seasonal, or emergency purposes. Travel trailers can be up to 8 ½ feet wide in travel position and (except tent trailers) have four permanent walls when in travel position.

- These plates are issued at DMV offices and by mail. These plates can be [customized](#) using letters or numbers of your choice for an additional fee.
- Registration is valid for two years.
- If you also need a title, follow the [title instructions](#); otherwise, complete a [Registration Application](#).

Truck

Trucks are designed or used to carry loads other than passengers.

- If your truck is **over 26,000 pounds** you need to contact [Motor Carrier](#); if the vehicle can be registered with DMV you will need to complete a [Registration Certification](#).
- If the vehicle has a taxable gross weight of 55,000 pounds or more you must provide a copy of the Heavy Vehicle Use Tax Return ([IRS Form 2290](#)).
- When registering a commercial truck, your signature on the application certifies that you comply with federal drug and alcohol testing requirements. To find out if you are subject to this federal law, contact [Motor Carrier](#).
- A Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) [Certificate of Compliance](#) may be required if you are in a DEQ area.
- These plates are issued at DMV offices and by mail.
- Registration is valid for the amount of quarters you apply for, up to one year.
- If you also need a title, follow the [title instructions](#); otherwise, complete a [Registration Application](#).

Utility/Light Trailer

Light trailers have a loaded weight of 8,000 pounds or less.

- A light trailer under 1,800 pounds loaded weight does not have to be titled and registered, but you may title and register it if you choose to.
- Registration is valid for four years for a brand new light trailer or two years for any other light trailer.
- If you also need a title, follow the [title instructions](#); otherwise, complete a [Registration Application](#).

Charitable/Non Profit

You and the vehicle must qualify for these plates. Information on the [Charitable/Non-Profit Certification](#) may help you determine if you qualify. If you are unsure if you qualify or if you need an exemption number, contact [Motor Carrier](#) before completing the form.



Fleet Vehicles

This plate style is for qualifying Oregon-based companies who register 50 or more vehicles used intrastate. Fleet vehicles can be passenger vehicles, buses, trucks, light trailers, heavy fixed load, or light fixed load.



For-Rent Trailers

This plate style is for trailers with a loaded weight of 8,000 pounds or less (except for travel trailers, bus trailers or truck trailers) that are for hire and have pneumatic tires.



Heavy Fixed Load

This plate style is for fixed load vehicles over 3,000 pounds that are **not** designed or used primarily to transport persons or property (not including travel trailers, tow trucks, truck-mounted transit mixers, self-propelled cranes or farm equipment).



Light Fixed Load

This plate style is for fixed load vehicles 3,000 pounds or less that are **not** designed or used primarily to transport persons or property (not including travel trailers, tow trucks, truck-mounted transit mixers, self-propelled cranes or farm equipment).



Low-Speed Vehicles

This plate style is for four-wheeled motor vehicles with a maximum speed of more than 20 mph but not more than 25 mph. The vehicle must meet Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 500 (CFR 571.500).



Medium-Speed Vehicles

This plate style is for four-wheeled electric motor vehicles with a roll cage or crushproof body design that have a maximum speed of 35 mph on a paved, level surface. The vehicle must be fully enclosed and have at least one door for entry.



School Bus

This plate style is for buses and school activity vehicles used exclusively to transport school children to and from school or school activities. Available for public and private vehicles.



Special Use Trailer

This plate style is for trailers 8 ½ feet wide or less with any length, used for commercial or business purposes and trailers used temporarily on a construction site for office purposes only.



Tow/Recovery Vehicle

This plate style is for [certified transporters](#) (companies or individuals).
