Tree

The tree plate is **Oregon’s standard passenger plate**. These plates are available at DMV offices and by mail. They can be customized using letters or numbers of your choice for an additional fee. If you have an all-electric vehicle enrolled in [OReGO](#), [contact DMV](#) for fees.
