

Amateur (HAM) Radio Operator

If you have an all-electric vehicle enrolled in [OReGO](#), [contact DMV](#) for fees.

To qualify you must:

- Have a valid amateur radio license;
- Submit an [Application for Amateur Radio Operator Plates](#) with your [title](#) or [registration application](#).

Antique

Antique registration is permanent and only one plate is issued. Any vehicle that can be registered may get Antique registration if it meets the antique requirements listed below.

To qualify:

- Your vehicle must be maintained as a collector's item;
- Your vehicle must be older than half the number of years between the current year and 1900; and
- You must submit an [Antique Vehicle Declaration](#) with your [title](#) or [registration application](#).

National Guard

To qualify you must provide proof that you are an active member of the Oregon National Guard by submitting an Oregon Military Certificate of Eligibility, AGO Form 4309 with your [title](#) or [registration application](#). You can contact your unit commander to get Form 4309. If you have an all-electric vehicle enrolled in [OReGO](#), [contact DMV](#) for fees.

Special Interest

Special Interest registration is permanent and only one plate is issued.

To qualify:

- Your vehicle must be maintained as a collector's item;
- Your vehicle must be:
 - At least 25 years old;
 - Sanctioned as Special Interest;
 - A street rod
 - A high-mobility multipurpose wheeled vehicle (HMMWV); or
 - A racing activity vehicle; and
- You must submit a [Special Interest Vehicle Declaration](#) with your [title](#) or [registration application](#).

Special Interest Registration (if you want to provide your own plate, contact DMV)	Vehicle does not have Special Interest plate	\$112
	Replacing Special Interest plate previously issued	\$22
Transfer Plate	Moving Special Interest (SP) plate to another qualifying vehicle (you will also owe \$100 if you do not own the vehicle the plates were removed from)	\$6
